# **OUR NURSERY**

Each child in our nursery is a very special person.

On Sunday mornings, the nursery is open at 9:15 a.m. and closes at 11:30 a.m.

The nursery is for children **four years of age and under** during the school year. (It may be used by those five years of age and under during the summer and on Sundays when regular Christian Formation classes are not offered).

Children aged a few weeks to 4 years old need different things. We try to provide whatever they need--a place to sleep, get changed, drink from a bottle or a cup, play games, listen to a story or whatever. We are indebted to parishioners who have provided books and games.

Two members of the nursery staff are REQUIRED to be on duty each Sunday. All nursery staff are required to attend the Diocese's Safeguarding God's Children Workshop. There is a Workshop on **Sunday, August 26** from 2-5 pm at St. Martin of Tours Church, Kalamazoo. Also, if you would like to **volunteer once a month**, please contact the Parish Office.


