FORESTRY UPDATE



The property has been surveyed. We had more cherry trees ready for harvesting south of the rectory than we had expected.

Mark Jenke, CF & ACF, identified 97 Cherry, 16 Red Oak, 3 Black Oak, 1 Hickory, and 1 White Oak that can be removed without negatively impacting the woods surrounding the church.

If the weather cooperates, it should be done by June.



OLDER BUNCH FOR LUNCH




We are hosting Older Bunch for Lunch on Thursday, May 2 at 12:00 noon.
